Ducati Officially announces their Thunder Team for 2007

Kevin Davis of Ducati Canada is very pleased to announce their plans for the Parts Canada SuperBike Championship.

Competing in the Thunder Class on the ultra popular Paul Smart Sport Classic's (PS1000LE) for the Ducati Team will be Chad Pasowisty of Calgary Alberta, Jimmy Dickenson from Courtland Ontario and Corey Warren residing in Oakville Ontario.

Chad brings a wealth of talent and speed to this Team. He was the National Pro rookie of the year in 2000 and more recently won the CMRA SuperBike #1 plate in 2005. Last season Chad raced in the Calgary round on a stock Ducati SuperSport, taking a very impressive 3rd place against the factory built bikes.

Jimmy has raced several different disciplines including Motocross and Supermoto, both in Canada and the U.S. He joined the series at the Calgary round last year and competed on a Ducati SuperSport for the remainder of the season.

Corey raced 600's for a number of years prior to his most recent duties of Crew Chief and Manager for the Ducati Racing effort. Having success on both sides of the pit wall, Corey is looking forward to getting back in the saddle and more specifically on a Ducati. Corey's duties will also include managing the Team for the 07 season.

Norm Reed, long time mechanic and friend of Chad will act as Crew Chief for the Team and will be Chad's lead mechanic.

Adding another dimension to the Team will be the support of three top-notch Canadian Ducati dealers. Rivoluzione of Calgary, Ducati Toronto and Inglis Cycle located in London Ontario.

The Team will also enjoy support from Team partners such as Performance Under Gear, Flexi-Glass, NCR, Kingcom Media and others soon to be announced.
